

Terms and Conditions STRONGMAN BATTLES

A. Definitions

1. Event; The event STRONGMAN BATTLES
2. Participant; the natural person who has registered for participation in the Event in the manner permitted by the Organizer
3. Agreement; the agreement for the participation of the Participant in the Event
4. Organizer; Strength Events Group

B. Participation

1. Participation in the Event is only possible by the Participant if he has completed the registration form completely and truthfully, if the registration fee is completed and if the 'Participation fully at your own risk statement' has been signed.
2. Participation in the event is done by the Participant personally.
3. The minimum age to participate in the Event is 16 years (or becomes 16 in that calendar year). If a Participant is younger than 16 years of age at the time of registration for the Event, he/she is obliged to request permission from a parent / guardian for registration.
4. Ticket purchases are final and non-refundable. In case of withdrawal, you have a one-time option to move your registration forward to the next Battles edition. This option is only valid once and must be requested at least 4 weeks before the event date. After this deadline, the right to reschedule your participation expires and you will need to complete a new registration for the next edition.
5. The Organizer may decide to not proceed with the event on the basis of exceptional circumstances. In case of Event cancellation by the Organizer the Participant is entitled to a full refund within 8 weeks after Event date.
6. The Participant must follow instructions from Event staff or crew at all time. In case of repeated or serious misconduct, the Organizer reserves the right to discontinue participation in the Event at any time, without claiming any costs or registration fees.
7. The Participant declares to not undertake any commercial activities on behalf of the Organizer without the express permission of the Organizer.

C. Liability

1. Participation is at your own risk. The Organizer is not liable for any damage, by whatever name, the Participant may suffer as a result of the participation. The Organizer is also not liable for any loss, theft or damage to property.
2. If, despite the provisions of the first paragraph of this article, liability must be assumed on the part of the Organizer, for damage suffered by the Participant, the Organizer's obligation to compensate for that damage will be limited to a maximum of the amount that the Organizer's insurer in respect of that pays for those kind of damages.
3. The Participant must be insured adequately against the risk of damage that he, or a surviving relative, may suffer as a result of his death, injury or illness, caused by his participation in the Event.
4. The Participant declares that he is aware of participating requires a good health, in both a psychological and physical sense, and declares that he meets this requirement and he has sufficiently prepared for the Event through training and otherwise. The Participant is obliged to report relevant medical circumstances to the Organizer.

5. The Participant indemnifies the Organizer against damage, third parties may suffer, as a result of an act or omission attributable to the Participant with regard to the Event. The Participant must be insured adequately against the risk of liability for the damage referred to.

D. Portrait right

The Participant grants permission in advance to the Organizer for the publication of photos, images and other kind of footage taken during and/or around the Event, which the Participant is visible on.

E. Visual material

The Organizer reserves the right to publish visual material made by a Participant during the Event in any medium whatsoever without stating the owner or source.

F. Personal data

1. The personal data, provided by the Participant, are included in a file by the Organizer. The Organizer is authorized, with the signing of the agreement by Participant, to provide the personal data to third parties for the benefit of providing information to the Participant. The Participant is allowed to object at all times, written or by e-mail and for free, to the provision of sending information or personal data by the Organizer. After which the Organizer will stop distributing it. The Participant authorized the Organizer, by signing the agreement, to publish the name and the event results of the Participant on the internet and other media.
2. When registering, the Participant is responsible for the correctness of his/her personal data.
